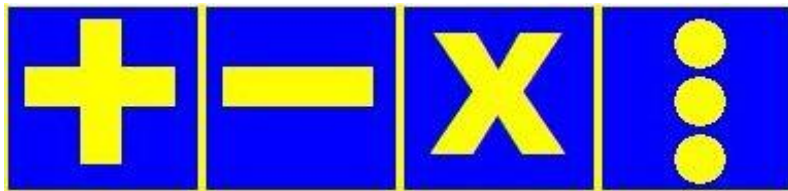


## EZReader Magnification Application

As part of its Ease-of-Use Settings, Windows provides a means of magnifying the entire screen or just part of the screen. However, it takes several steps to activate and manage the magnification capability, steps which are difficult for low vision users to complete.

EZReader provides 4 simple icons that make it very easy to access the Ease-of-Use Magnification settings. The icons may be found on the EZTaskBar or the EZCenterBar.



- **Activate Magnification** - press the large plus icon
- **Increase Magnification** - press the large plus icon repeatedly
- **Decrease Magnification** - press the large minus icon
- **Exit Magnification** - press the large X icon
- **Magnification Type** - press the triple-dot icon to cycle through the 3 types of magnification

The magnification type refers to 2 settings that Windows offers:

- **Full Screen** - the entire screen is magnified. it will extend offscreen and requires vertical and horizontal scrolling
- **Lens** - a re-sizable area around the cursor is magnified

Generally, users find the Lens option easier to see and use. It is the default magnification type EZReader is set to show.
